Text of the review:

The M-Line marks at German Maestro the best products as made in a good old handcrafting manufacturing process, leaving the Obrigheim manufactory. The 6,5" Compo MS 6508 at Euro 950,- was recently named as "MB Quart QSF Nano" (review in autohifi 6/2007) and is sailing now under a new flag.

Except of the new carton inlay from red velvet, there is generally no significant change.

In the lab the newcomer behaves – except minor tolerances- as same as his antecessor and sounds in a direct comparison nearly identically. The minimal smoother appearance of voices was within the tolerance, so that the over all evaluation results as before (with the MB Quart QSF 216 Nano):
